The Goldstein Museum of Design is pleased to announce the appointment of Lin Nelson-Mayson as Director, effective September 1. Nelson-Mayson comes to The Goldstein from leadership positions in the museum field including Director of ExhibitsUSA in Kansas City, Curator for the Minnesota Museum of American Art in St. Paul, and Deputy Director for Curatorial Services at the Columbia Museum of Art in Columbia, South Carolina. She received her Bachelor's in Fine Arts with an emphasis in painting from Miami University in Oxford, Ohio, and her Master's of Fine Arts with an emphasis in sculpture and critical writing from The Ohio State University. She has extensive experience with decorative arts and curatorial design and is an accomplished speaker, having lectured widely on museums and the issues integral to them. She served as chair of the Curator's Committee for the American Association of Museums (1992-1994), chair of the Minnesota Association of Museums (1998-2000), and board member for the Association of Midwest Museums (2002-2005). Her success with program and fund-raising initiatives and her strong commitment to professional museum organizations are a few of the accomplishments that she will bring to The Goldstein Museum of Design. Nelson-Mayson states, "I am honored to be the incoming director of The Goldstein Museum of Design and glad to be a part of such a dynamic operation. I anticipate being able to draw on my past museum experiences as well as work more intensively with design, students, and the public.
